Fundamentals of Inventory Management Overview:

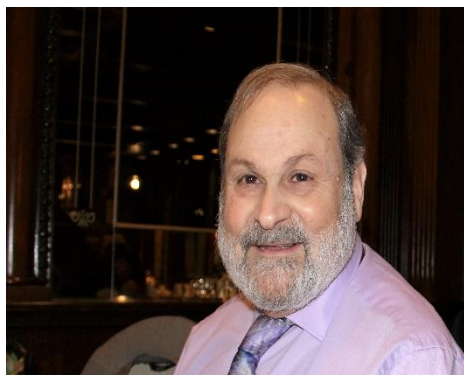
All businesses, even purely service ones, require inventories in some way, shape or manner to be profitable. Often, inventories are a substantial part of total assets.
